- Wells are holding up with record pumpage at almost 4 million gallon monthly usage.
- The invoice cloud is still not on-line.
- There has been a slight increase in past due billings.
- No meters were replaced in August.
- On September 6 the #1 well went down. The pump is destroyed. It will be evaluated for cause and repaired. The estimated cost is \$5,000. For now well #3 is carrying the full load w/o problem. A motion to pre-authorize up to \$5,000 for repair was made by Dan, second by Kyle. Motion passed 4-0-0.
- Discussion of a \$1,062 water bill due a leak (customer side) was deferred until our October meeting.

- Repair at the meter @ 1105 S. Gabriel (Texas Water \$700). Motion to pay made by Dan, second by Chuck. Motion passed 4-0-0.
- Bacteriological Testing (City of Round Rock \$20.00)

- Brazos River Authority Watermaster fees \$201.50.
- Emergency repair of 4" PVC Tee at road crossing on S. Gabriel Drive. Install 4" gate valve (Texas Water \$4,000). Motion to pay made by Aron, second by Kyle. Motion passed 4-0-0.

Treasurer's Report.

- Chuck presented the financial report. The report was accepted without comment.

Board Issues:

- A motion was made by Dan to move member comments forward in the meeting agenda to immediately following the approval of minutes.
